

Instructions for cleaning

Velvet

Clean the upholstery with a vacuum cleaner or brush.

Treat normal soiling with soapy water.

You can wash the adherent foam and fabric.

Treatment no. 1	Vacuum or brush off.	
Treatment no. 2 of a	Remove loose dirt, loosen any dried-on substances carefully with the blunt back knife or a spoon and vacuum off.	
Treatment no. 3	Remove soiling with lukewarm water and dab with a cloth.	
Treatment no. 4	Loosen dirt with soapy water or mild detergent off with clean water. Take up any moisture with	` '

Important:

Apply all cleaning agents indirectly using a cloth, apart from Havener Candle Wax Remover

<u>Each time after removing stains:</u>

Rinse spot with clean water and take up any moisture with an absorbent cloth.

Recommendations for cleaning:

Water-soluble stains Treatment no. 3

Grease marks Treatment no. 4

Stubborn stains

All-purpose adhesive Acetone and treatment no. 4
Carbon black, resin Kerosene and treatment no. 4

Wall paint Treatment no. 4 and then treat with solvent Flower stains Ethyl alcohol and treatment no. 4

Cooking fat Treatment no. 4 and then dab with ethyl alcohol

Oil-based paint Kerosene and remove using solvent

Urine Treatment no. 4 and then treat with a solution of vinegar and water

Patch of excrement Treatment no. 4 and then treat with ammonium chloride (sal ammoniac)

Vomit Treatment no. 4 and then treat with ammonium chloride (sal ammoniac)
